## PROGRAM IN SACRED ART

Sagrada Art Studios offer competent students an opportunity to produce beautiful religious art in the Land of Enchantment, in Albuquerque, New Mexico. The program at Sagrada, begun in 1970, envisions itself in an increasingly important role as an educational center for all who are concerned with religious worship and art in the Christian tradition.

Students may work in the areas of —

- The Fine Arts
- Liturgical Art
- Sacred Design
- Performing Arts

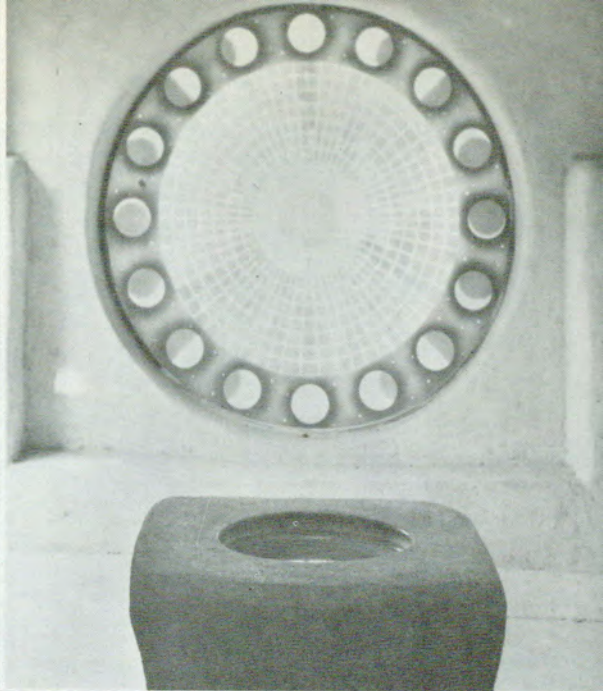
Courses are given in fall and spring semesters and in winter and summer short terms.

At SAGRADA an artist in any medium can take time to explore the relationship between art and the sacred. Courses range from slide lectures on the history of symbols to more specific areas, such as, liturgy and art, and music and art.

The artist is given time and space in which to create. One becomes a member of a small, on-going, self-supporting community where individual needs are met and methods of study and performance are flexible.

Indian pueblos, Spanish churches and shrines of New Mexico provide an insight into the symbolic language of several cultures.





The desert and canyon country and the clear light of the southwest are a fitting setting for artistic expression of many dimensions.

Life at SAGRADA in Albuquerque's Old Town gives a deep sense of religious tradition to one's purpose and work. It is enriched by study, friendships, shared worship, interchange of ideas, freedom of life style and meals in common. Artists may partially support themselves by working in the restaurant, JOSEPH'S TABLE.

Full enrollment allows one to have a studio at SAGRADA and to exhibit works in the Gallery. Those who pursue the Graduate Equivalent Degree, the Master's Degree in Sacred Art, may transfer it to other institutions on an individual basis. Single courses may be taken for credit or audit. Students of any religion are welcome although the program has a Judaeo-Christian basis.

The Center for Liturgy in Santa Fe is closely allied with the program since exchange professors teach at both locations, Santa Fe and Albuquerque.

Semester courses are in: Christian Iconography, Liturgy and the Arts, Sacred Scripture, Festival Dance, Sacred Song, Electives or Independent Study.

Costs: \$800 each semester for full enrollment, includes tuition, a half-studio, three dinner meals per week.  
\$30 per credit hour for single courses.  
\$25 per hour for auditors.
